To be eligible, you must:

- Be a High School student (entering 10th – 12th grade)
- Be able to attend Teen Committee Meetings the 3rd Wednesday of each month, September through May, 4:00pm-5:00pm at Art Students League of Denver. Missing more than 3 meetings will result in dismissal from the Teen Committee.
- Serve at least one school year term (September-May) that will consist of a minimum of four community projects or events. All members must attend and participate in the events. All members are expected to assist with the planning, preparation, and execution of these events.
 - Applicant must be able to commit to events on nights and weekends as needed.
 - Time commitment may vary, but participants will contribute approximately 20 service hours per semester.
 - You may serve two consecutive terms.
