## ASLD Ceramics Studio Summer Assistantship – Part-Time Temporary Position

Pay rate: \$11.50/hour

Dates: June 5 – August 18, 2017

Location: Art Students League of Denver, 200 Grant Street, Denver, CO

Responsibilities – Assist the Ceramics Studio Manager and Studio Assistant in the ceramics studio, including cleaning, maintenance, kiln loading/unloading and other duties as needed.

Work hours: This position is 10 hours per week divided into two 5 hour days. Work days are every Monday afternoon and one alternating Saturday and Friday every other week, to assist in loading and unloading kilns, studio upkeep, and other studio activities as requested by supervisor.

Experience required: Background in ceramics – minimum two-three years in the field at either the college level or in a studio environment. Preference will be given to a current ceramics student in a local program with related coursework or a candidate with equivalent familiarity with kiln loading as well as basic knowledge of glaze materials, firing processes, clay bodies, studio practices, etc.

The Summer Assistant will work under the supervision of the ceramics studio manager. Must be responsible, self-motivated, able to interact with people easily, able to commit to the above schedule, willing to listen to and follow instructions and able to lift 50-75 lbs. References will be checked for compatible work habits and level of ceramics knowledge.

The assistant may use the ceramics studio during open studio time when not working, as well as have a small amount of work fired during the assistantship. Assistant must pay for clay, using clay available for purchase at ASLD.
