Submission Guidelines

- Each artist must complete the Open Call Entry online at www.asld.org/boxing_callforentry or inperson at the ASLD at time of drop-off. An appointment for drop-off is required by contacting Holly K. Hurd at h.hurd@asld.org or call (303)778-6990 ext. 1108.
- Please attach a photo of your art work with your online submission form.
- Art work should not exceed dimensions of: 12" x 12" (unframed) or 14" x 14" (framed) for 2D works; and should not exceed 12" x 12" x 12" for 3D works.
- Work must be ready-to-hang or install.

Pedestals will be provided if necessary. Any additional equipment needed for display must be provided by the artist.

Two Dimensional Art & Framing Parameters

- All photographs or works on paper must be framed.
- NO plastic frames. Black or neutral toned frames only.
- Frames must be in good condition.
- Works on canvas must be framed or have gallery-wrapped, finished edges with no visible staples.
- Hanging wire must be firmly attached to the back with screw-eyes or D-rings. Wire should not
 exceed the top of the frame.
- NO saw-tooth hangers.

It is recommended that submitted works are wrapped in protective material such as paper, bubble wrap, boxes, etc. Your packaging materials will also be used to package work back up for the buyer. (wrapping may not be returned).

Submissions that do not meet theme and/or submission guidelines of the exhibit will be excluded at the discretion of ASLD.
